The Governor in Executive Order No. 202.1 ([click here](#) for full version) has relaxed the Open Meetings Law to allow meetings of public bodies to be held remotely by conference call or similar services. In light of the potential risks to public health and safety from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), the New York State Economic Development Council has recommended that all IDAs replace in person open meetings with remote telephonic or other digital meetings until the crisis has passed.

During this difficult time, COMIDA feels the best course of action is to have the March meeting, we want to keep business going in Monroe County, but do so in the most responsible and safe manner.

As a result, the in-person COMIDA meeting is canceled. The meeting will be held via telephone conference on March 17, 2020 at noon.
