GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT AND BACKGROUND ON USER(S) OF THE FACILITY

Sydor Instruments LLC dba Sydor Technologies is currently located at 291 Millstead Way, Rochester NY and will be moving its Headquartered operations to 78 Schuyler Baldwin Drive, Perinton, NY. This move is anticipated to take place during the 2nd-3rd qtr. of 2018 and is necessitated by the anticipated growing demands of the operations. The current facility at 291 Millstead is 100% owned by Sydor Technologies

Sydor Technologies will continue its operations in the new facility as it does today. This includes Manufacturing, Engineering, and R&D work all of which drive the revenue of the organization. As the company's headquarters, the office will continue to house the management function such as Administration, Finance, Sales, and Marketing. In addition Sydor will look to onshore some of its administrative activities now in the UK to the US as the new facility will be able to accommodate that growth as well.

In our move to the new location, its size (~41K sq. ft.) is significantly larger than Sydor's present location (~16K sq. ft.). The building has been purposed already for the Sydor's industry and will support the growth that is envisioned. Until Sydor obtains full occupancy, some space will be sublet over the next three-five years until Sydor grows fully into the building.

Organizationally a New Company will be formed with the anticipated name of 78 Schuyler Baldwin Dr and will own 100% of the building. Sydor Technologies will lease the space along with another should a tenant be signed on.

In addition to the building being purchased, there will be a purchase of approximately \$175K of manufacturing equipment that is located on site. Along with the acquisition, there will be some renovation work done to ready it for occupancy. This will involve hiring local labor to perform the work required, an architectural design firm and equipment to create the collaborative engineering work environment. Also there are planned two to three dark rooms along with a production layout to support a streamlined work flow for manufacturing and testing.

The acquisition of this building is a key step and a great opportunity at this time. It is one in a series of planned initiatives that Sydor is engaging in for 2018 that is critical to support the needs 3-5 years out. The support of the ESD will also be critical in the acquisition of this building.
